#### PATIENT PALS AND PLAYROOM VOLUNTEERS

**AVAILABILITY: WEEKDAYS; 9:30AM - 12PM; 11PM-2PM; 2PM - 5PM; 6PM - 8PM**

**WEEKENDS; 9:30AM - 12PM; 11PM-2PM, 2PM - 5PM**

Work alongside Child Life Staff in the playroom assisting with various activities and arts and crafts projects or provide support to clinical staff by holding and rocking babies, entertaining patients in their rooms, scrap booking, providing patient pampering, transporting patients or items, assisting at nursing stations, visiting with families and much more! (Monday-Friday from 9:30 AM to 12 PM is infant and toddler time only in the Playroom.)

#### CLASSROOM VOLUNTEER
